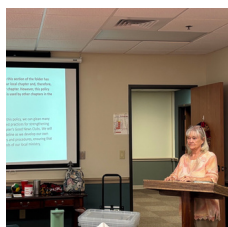
From Summer Ministry to a New School Year

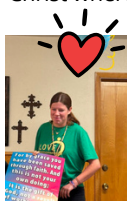
-Volunteer Spotlight-
