In the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, here's an encouraging report from Bunny Baldwin, Good News Club teacher at Bushland Elementary:

If school had resumed after spring break, we would have had three more weeks of Good News Clubs. The lesson series has been on the apostle Paul, and our Wonder Time has discussed the Armor of God. As this is such as important lesson for our children today, I wanted them to have the information they would have learned in the last three clubs. While we thought of mailing it out, we decided to ask parents to come by the local Pak-A-Sak and pick up goodie bags for their kids. We had a great response, and the children were thankful!
