Until Every Child Hears

As one season of ministry comes to a close, another is already beginning. We continue to thank God for every opportunity He gives us to share the Gospel with children across the Texas Panhandle and beyond.



One of the highlights of our summer was **Camp Good News** in *Hardesty, Oklahoma*, where 54 children from across West Texas gathered for a week of Bible teaching, worship, recreation, and lasting friendships. Some arrived carrying emotional burdens, uncertain of what the week would hold, while others came from difficult home situations. Yet throughout the week, they experienced the love of Christ through caring counselors, faithful Bible teaching, and the encouragement of Christian community.

We rejoice that **6 children placed their faith in Jesus Christ, and 2 others found reassurance of their salvation.** What a beautiful reminder that God continues to change lives as His Word is faithfully shared. While camp has come to an end, the mission is far from over. As summer draws to a close, we are already preparing to launch Good News Clubs and After-school Clubs.



Independent school districts across our area begin classes in August. New opportunities to reach children with the hope of the Gospel are just around the corner, and we are excited to see how God will continue working in the hearts of children this school year.

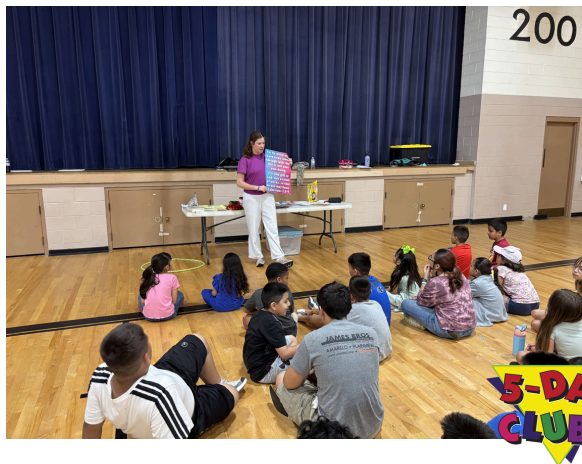
