From the moment guests arrived, there was a sense of anticipation and joy as supporters, volunteers, and friends of the ministry gathered with a shared purpose—to celebrate what God has done and to step forward in faith for what He will continue to do.

One of the most impactful parts of the *Vision Dinner* was hearing testimonies from both those currently involved in CEF and those who were reached through the ministry in years past. These stories served as a beautiful reminder that the Gospel continues to transform lives far beyond the moment it is first shared. We were also honored to hear from our guest speaker, Jeff Nichols, who challenged and inspired us with a vivid picture today's youth.

He compared it to a sports game—reminding us that we are not just spectators, but invited to step onto the field and be part of what God is doing. In a generation often counted out, we have the opportunity to watch God move in powerful ways as we faithfully share His truth. In 2025, 1,367 children heard the Gospel, 46 clubs were held, and 107 children made professions of faith across the Panhandle. These numbers represent lives changed and the continued faithfulness of God at work through the ministry. Thank you to each table host, volunteer, and supporter who made this evening possible. Because of you, we are able to continue reaching the next generation with the hope of Christ.
